A THOUGHT FOR TODAY | I HAVE TOLD YOU

John's Gospel is full of people repeatedly asking Jesus the same questions and not listening to his answers, so it is not surprising that occasionally we hear a note of exasperation in his voice: have told you, and you do not believe. It is the voice of the teacher in every age; it is the voice of the parent; and if it is the voice of Jesus speaking to us as well as those who hear him in the Gospel account, we need to take note and to take heed. Two thousand years of reflection and action have responded to the voice and teaching of Jesus; there really is little excuse if we continue to fail to listen and fail to believe:
