## A THOUGHT FOR TODAY

The theme of today's readings are something of a two-sided coin; on one side, we have 'Error and Condemnation' and on the other side, we have 'Forgiveness and Reconciliation'. God is always ready to forgive, but do we only want that forgiveness to be as much as we forgive someone else in our lives? Be mindful of what it is that you pray for; you may only get that much in return. Something for us to think about during the week ahead as we sit with what it actually means to pray those words: 'Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us'.
